Community Team

Katy from the community team asked for more feedback about the sex and relationships pathway.

She said that most referrals to the pathway were around safety and boundaries. Referrals are often for urgent care.

Sue said that it would be good if providers were more confident to support people with sex and relationships. Spring into Action have been offering workshops in 5 areas over the last year. Funding for this has now ended.

Sue also said that people didn't know that training can be set off against financial assessments.

It is sometimes unclear who should provide support around sex and relationships – Health services or Social Care services.
